

# **THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN TIME MANAGEMENT AND ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT OF WORKING STUDENTS**

ABSTRACT :

Learning is a process conducted by a person to achieve the desired goal. In the study, one will get good academic achievements. In order to have good achievement the student should share more time and attention to his/her studies. However, many students going to school also work. The problem is that these working students should be able to manage their time as well as possible. The focus of this study is time management conducted by the working students and its relationship with their achievement. When talking about students achievement, IQ is also one important factor. This study tried to control IQ. The subjects involved in this study are those of the level of IQ. Hypothesis testing is done by using partial correlation. Based on data analysis by using partial correlation coefficient of correlation  $r$  obtained 0053 with a significance of 0359 ( $p > 0.05$ ), it is found that there is no significant relationship between time management and academic achievement with working students who work. In this case it seems that the academic achievement of the students is highly determined by the system of the university.
